"Many residents of the parish and friends from neighbouring parishes have been involved in the many fundraising events organised by the Parish Hall Committee. Three major issues arose towards the end of the year -

Firstly. The steering group initiated by the Parish Council took the first steps in creating a Parish plan

Secondly. There have been a number of complaints about HGV's. I thank Mr Belmont, Operations Manager for William Sinclair Ltd, for the help he has given us in sorting this problem out.

Thirdly. Within the National "Lost Ways" project Cllr Harry Kay and friends have trekked each of the sixteen footpaths mapped for the parish.
